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Halloween at Power Glen

Tuesday, October 31 will be a day full of activities.

In the morning, there are several activities happening.

- All Kindergarten classes are **having a parade starting at 9:00 a.m.** (Parade: starting from the students' entrance door in the morning, around the outside back of the school and back in through the junior/intermediate entrance doors. The students on the second floor will be outside to see the students. The Kindergarten students will also visit each of the classrooms on the first floor). Families are welcome to watch the parade outside. After this, the students will have Halloween activities. **All Kindergarten students should come to school already dressed in their costumes for the day.**
- Grades 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 will participate in Halloween literacy, and/or numeracy and/or art activities.
- Grades 7 and 8 will participate in the regular school timetable.
- The Fundamental Skills class will have Halloween Activities.

Wearing Costumes: During the second nutrition/fitness break, students (Grades 1-8) will put on their costumes. (Note: please try to limit the accessories so the students won't lose them.) Just a reminder that **costumes are to be non-violent and weapons are not permitted at school.**



Our primary parade will approximately begin at 1:30 p.m. All students in Grade 1, 2, and 3 will participate in the parade. (Note: Grade 4s will watch the parade.)

The parade route will be: Out the primary entrance doors and around the back of the school, walk along the playground equipment parking lot side and come through the front entrance doors of the school.

If it rains, both the parades will be held inside throughout the school. Families are welcome to come into the school and stand in the hallways to see the parade.

After the parade:

- Kindergarten classes will have Halloween activities. Treats are welcome.
- Grade 1s will have Halloween activities. An email or note will go home this week to plans treats.
- Grade 2, 2/3, 3 and 3/4 will have Halloween Activities. Parents/ Guardians may send treats for the class if they wish.
- Grade 4, 5, 5/6 and 6 will have Halloween Activities between the four classes. A note went home last week.
- Fundamental Skills: Students in Grades 3 to 6 will integrate into the activities for their grade level. Students in Grades 7 and 8 will go to the dance and attend the Pot Luck Lunch at noon. Parents/ Guardians may send treats for the class if they wish.
- Grade 7 and 8 will have a Halloween Dance after the parade. Entrance fee: \$1.00 if student is wearing a costume and \$2.00 if a student does not wear a costume. The money will be used to purchase prizes to be given out at the dance. The Intermediate division will be holding a Halloween Pot Luck Lunch. Hot dishes should be dropped off at 11:45 a.m. Students are eating at noon.

Please remember to avoid treats containing nuts, sesame seeds (humus), eggs (egg allergy in Grade 5 and 8), kiwi, melon and fish (Grade 6), and shellfish (Grade 6 and 8).
